

WORK INCENTIVES

Allow people with disabilities to keep their cash resources and medical benefits as they work to become self supporting

Examples of Work Incentives

► Impairment Related Work Expense

Disability related work expenses necessary in order to work or perform a job, that adjusts the countable income for SSA purposes

► Trial Work Period

A 9-month period when a person receiving SSDI can test their ability to work without losing SSDI cash payments and Medicare coverage

► Plan to Achieve Self Support (PASS)

A plan to set aside income or resources to help reach a work goal

► Extended Period of Eligibility

A period of time an SSDI beneficiary can receive an SSDI payment when they earn below a certain level

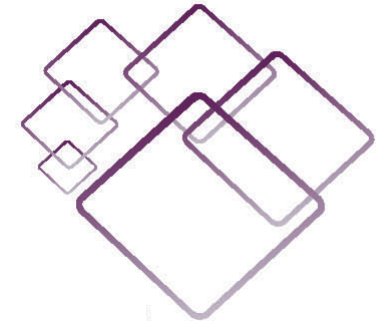
